

Large Scale Foam Operations For Crude & Ethanol Oil In Transit

Jim Cottrell will talk about developing logistics (supply chain) strategies for large fires events where big water and big foam supplies are mission critical. These operations were once the purview of specialized industrial fire departments who were or still are relied upon to provide "Big Gun" support whenever needed.

This program is designed to give the attendee an appreciation for what's needed to support firefighting and or spill security operations at crash events where 50 to 5,000 gpm foam streams are required.



This program is intended for state or regional emergency management supervisors, strategic planners, operations officers, specification writers and combat supply chain managers who now face industrial size fire risks on local roads, rail and maritime lanes.

The attendee will learn the importance of foam stream application techniques, stream reach, fuel coverage and frequency of reapplication.

Large scale demonstrations will show simple foam proportioning and distribution techniques for medium and large foam operations.
